



Margaret Wynn Memorial Nursing Scholarship

Margaret Wynn spent her career as a nurse and worked in Great Falls for many years. It was Margaret's desire to help nurses employed at Benefis Healthcare to advance their education in her chosen profession. This scholarship will assist a Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN), Emergency Medical Technician (EMT), or a Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA) to obtain an Associate Degree in Nursing (ADN) or a Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) Degree. It also provides the opportunity for a current Registered Nurse (RN) to obtain a BSN and the opportunity for an RN with a BSN Degree to pursue a specialty training certification or a post-graduate degree.

This scholarship, administered by Benefis Healthcare Foundation, provides for books and tuition up to \$2,500 per student per semester.

Applicant must meet the following criteria:

- Be a current employee of Benefis Healthcare or one of its subsidiaries.
- Be a Licensed Practical Nurse, Certified Nursing Assistant, or Emergency Medical Technician. Registered Nurses who are pursuing a Bachelor of Science Degree in Nursing (BSN) also shall be eligible, as are BSN's who are pursuing specialty training certification or a post-graduate degree.
- Applicant must pursue an Associate Degree in Nursing (ADN) or Bachelor of Science Degree in Nursing (BSN) or, if applicant is a BSN, must pursue specialty training certification or post-graduate degree.
- Applicant must take a minimum of nine (9) credits per semester.
- Applicant must maintain a 3.00 Grade Point Average (GPA).
- Complete Consent and Disclosure form.
- Applicant must participate in a personal interview with a selection committee formed by Benefis Healthcare Foundation to administer the scholarship program.

Scholarship funding is renewable. A renewable application must be completed and submitted along with grade documentation by May 15th for summer and fall renewals and October 1st for spring renewals.
